**DESIGNATING THE CITIES OF DIGOS, MATI, AND TAGUM AS
ADDITIONAL TESTING CENTERS FOR THE SEPTEMBER 2022
LICENSURE EXAMINATION FOR PROFESSIONAL TEACHERS**

WHEREAS, Section 7 (d) of Republic Act No. 8981 or the "PRC Modernization Act of 2000" empowers the Professional Regulation Commission (Commission) to administer and conduct the licensure examinations of the various regulatory boards in accordance with the rules and regulations it may promulgate and **to determine and fix the places and dates of examinations**;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 1439 (s. 2021), the schedule of the Licensure Examination for Professional Teachers (LEPT) is on September 25, 2022;

WHEREAS, the Commission issued Resolution No. 1493 (s. 2022) which provides that additional testing centers for large-scale examination outside the city or province where the PRC Regional Office is located must have at least three hundred (300) prospective examinees;

WHEREAS, LEPT is a large-scale licensure examination and there are more or less one thousand two hundred fifty (1,250), six hundred fifty (650) and two thousand three hundred (2,300) prospective examinees for the September 2022 LEPT in the cities of Digos, Mati and Tagum, respectively;

WHEREAS, PRC Davao Regional Office, in its Memorandum dated August 11, 2022, expressed that it has no objection to the inclusion of the cities of Digos, Mati and Tagum as additional testing centers for the September 2022 LEPT;

WHEREAS, the Board and the Licensure Office recommend the approval of the request in order to give the concerned examinees the opportunity to take the September 2022 LEPT without unnecessary distant travel and additional expenses;

WHEREFORE, the Commission **RESOLVES**, as it is hereby **RESOLVED**, to designate the cities of **DIGOS, MATI, and TAGUM** as additional testing centers for the **September 2022 Licensure Examination for Professional Teachers**.

All Commission offices/divisions are enjoined to undertake the necessary coordination to ensure the smooth and orderly conduct of the licensure examination.
